



Non-traditional Student Scholarship

Cosmopolitan Women's Club (CWC) is proud to announce our offering of college scholarships to non-traditional students. Non-traditional students sometimes fall outside of the preconceived norms for college-bound students. Many students choose to postpone college, or move directly into the workforce bypassing a university education altogether. It is only later that they decide to pursue a higher education, either to improve their professional opportunities, or to expand their general knowledge. Still other students may have had their college careers interrupted, either by growing families or financial difficulties, and only later return to complete what they had started. Many non-traditional, or returning, students can feel left out of the scholarship equation. CWC recognizes this need in the community and are excited about this opportunity to support non-traditional students.

Non-traditional students are classified as:

- Single parents: single mothers or single fathers
- Adult learners
- Students who didn't go directly to college after graduating high school or receiving their GED, and who are starting their higher education later in life
- Students who have experienced an interruption in their higher education for some years, and are returning to complete their degree

The following factors will be considered for each applicant:

- Personal circumstances and achievements
- Challenges faced in life
- Educational and career goals
- Financial need
- Impact of scholarship

Important Dates:

- Scholarship period begins **February 1, 2019**
- Application period ends **March 31, 2019**
- Award recipients will be notified by **May 10, 2019** via email and/or phone call
- Scholarship program will be held **Sunday, June 9th 3-5pm** at Elmira College's Cowles Hall
 - Scholarship award recipients should attend the program or send a representative to avoid forfeiture of the award. Special circumstances will be considered.

Non-traditional Student Scholarship

Requirements:

- *Meet the non-traditional student classification described above and be at least 24 years old.*
- *Pursuing a technical or vocational education, an associate's degree, or a bachelor's degree no later than fall 2018*
- *Maintain an 80.0 average as evidenced by school transcript or other official school document. This document should reflect your overall average thus far for the 2018/2019 academic year*
- *Scholarship is for **African-American male or female** students.*
- Applicant must live in **Chemung or Steuben County** and attend school in the local area.
- Applications should be submitted via email no later than **Sunday, March 31, 2019**
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Application Package Check List:

- Completed application questionnaire
- Official college transcript or other official school document that reflects your average as of Semester 1.
- Official high school transcripts if you have not yet started college and have completed high school within the last 10 years.
- Typed essay in 12 or 14 font with a maximum of 2 pages front to back double spaced
- Essay Content should include:
 - A brief introduction about you and your desires to pursue higher education.
 - Financial and social hardships that might impede your pursuits of higher education.
 - What major are you pursuing and why have you selected this major?
 - Who or what inspired you to seek a college degree?
 - Describe any community service activities in which you have participated.
- Signed Media Release Form and Scholarship Tracking Disclaimer
- Scan and send (via e-mail) your photo

Please keep first 2 pages for future reference. It is important that you follow ALL instructions and submit the requested information or you will forfeit your scholarship.
